(b) Penalty.--In addition to the [penalty] <u>penalties</u> imposed pursuant to <u>subsection (b.1) and</u> section 6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges), a person convicted of violating subsection (a) may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the first violation and not more than \$1,000 for the second and each subsequent violation.

19 (b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating 20 subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of 21 community service for a first violation and not more than 100 22 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation. 23 * * *
