- 16 (1) GRANTS SHALL BE NOT LESS THAN \$2,500 AND NOT MORE
- 17 THAN \$10,000 PER VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICE.
- 18 (2) GRANTS MAY BE AWARDED ON A PRO RATA BASIS IF THE
- 19 TOTAL DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE APPROVED APPLICATION EXCEEDS THE
- 20 AMOUNT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THIS
- 21 PURPOSE.

- 27 AMOUNT OF THE COMBINED TOTAL FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL
- 28 COMPANIES WOULD HAVE BEEN ELIGIBLE HAD THEY NOT CONSOLIDATED.
