- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special 2 plates for honorary consuls and official representatives of 3 foreign governments. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
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- § 1369.3. Special plates for honorary consuls and official
- 10 representatives of foreign governments.
- (a) General rule. -- Upon application of any person who is an 11
- 12 honorary consul or official representative of a foreign
- government, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in 13
- addition to the annual registration fee and by such 14
- 15 documentation as required under subsection (b), the department
- 16 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
- designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 17
- is an honorary consul or official representative of a foreign 18
- government. The special registration plate shall be of a 19

- 1 <u>distinguishing color and separate numerical series</u>. The special_
- 2 <u>registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck</u>
- 3 with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.
- 4 (b) Documentation required. -- The documentation required
- 5 <u>under subsection (a) shall consist of a copy of the honorary</u>
- 6 consul identification card or a copy of the exequatur issued by
- 7 the United States Department of State and any other
- 8 <u>documentation deemed necessary by the department.</u>
- 9 (c) Return of special registration plate. -- A person who has
- 10 been issued a special registration plate under this section
- 11 shall return it to the department if it is no longer in use or
- 12 the person is no longer an honorary consul or official
- 13 representative of the foreign government indicated on the
- 14 documentation submitted to the department.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
