10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

13	Section 2502.53. Growth Supplement for 2015-2016 School
14	Year(a) For the 2015-2016 school year, a growth supplement
15	shall be paid to qualifying school districts as follows:
16	(1) To qualify for the growth supplement, a school
17	<u>district's 2013-2014 average daily membership must be greater</u>
18	than its 2005-2006 average daily membership by three hundred
19	<u>fifty (350) average daily members.</u>
20	(2) The growth supplement shall be calculated for qualifying

1 <u>school districts as follows:</u>

2	(i) Subtract the school district's 2005-2006 average daily
3	membership from its 2013-2014 average daily membership.
4	(ii) Multiply the difference from clause (i) by twenty
5	<u>million dollars (\$20,000,000).</u>
6	(iii) Divide the product from clause (ii) by the sum of the
7	differences from clause (i) for all qualifying school districts.
8	(b) Payments to qualifying school districts shall be made no
9	<u>later than September 15, 2015.</u>
10	Section 2. The sum of \$20,000,000 is hereby appropriated to
