Section 9121(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 10 § 9121. General regulations. 11 12 Dissemination to noncriminal justice agencies and

- individuals .-- Criminal history record information shall be 14
- 15 disseminated by a State or local police department to any
- 16 individual or noncriminal justice agency only upon request.
- 17 Except as provided in subsection (b.1):
- 18 A fee may be charged by a State or local police (1)
- department for each request for criminal history record 19

- 1 information by an individual or noncriminal justice agency,
- 2 except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who
- makes the request in order to apply to become a volunteer and
- 4 <u>serve without compensation</u> with an affiliate of <u>Little League</u>
- 5 <u>Baseball, Inc.</u>, Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of
- 6 America or with a rape crisis center or domestic violence
- 7 program.
- 8 (2) Before a State or local police department
- 9 disseminates criminal history record information to an
- 10 individual or noncriminal justice agency, it shall extract
- from the record all notations of arrests, indictments or
- 12 other information relating to the initiation of criminal
- 13 proceedings where:
- 14 (i) three years have elapsed from the date of
- 15 arrest;
- 16 (ii) no conviction has occurred; and
- 17 (iii) no proceedings are pending seeking a
