## AN ACT

- Amending the act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.11, No.5), entitled "An act establishing a fixed minimum wage and overtime rates 2 for employes, with certain exceptions; providing for minimum 3 rates for learners and apprentices; creating a Minimum Wage Advisory Board and defining its powers and duties; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Labor and 6 Industry; imposing duties on employers; and providing penalties," further providing for minimum wages, for 7 8 exemptions and for preemption. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 11 12 Section 1. Section 4(a) of the act of January 17, 1968 13 (P.L.11, No.5), known as The Minimum Wage Act of 1968, is 14 amended by adding paragraphs to read: Section 4. Minimum Wages. -- Except as may otherwise be 15 16 provided under this act: 17 Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employes 18 wages for all hours worked at a rate of not less than: 19 20 (9) Seven dollars seventy-five cents (\$7.75) an hour

- 17 minimum wage higher than the minimum wage set forth in this act.
