10	SECTION 1. SECTION 7706 OF TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA <
11	CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED TO READ:
12	§ 7706. Restricted [account] ACCOUNTS. <
13	(a) Deposit and use of moneys
14	(1) [The department] There is established a restricted <
15	account with two separate funds, the ATV Management Fund and
16	the Snowmobile Management Fund. The department shall deposit
17	the following into [a] the appropriate fund of the restricted
18	<pre>account[, which is hereby established]:</pre>

1	(1) THE [DEPARTMENT] <u>ATV MANAGEMENT RESTRICTED ACCOUNT</u> <
2	AND THE SNOWMOBILE MANAGEMENT RESTRICTED ACCOUNT ARE
3	ESTABLISHED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
4	DEPOSIT THE FOLLOWING INTO [A] THE APPROPRIATE RESTRICTED
5	ACCOUNT[, WHICH IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED]:
6	(i) all moneys received from the registration of and
7	issuance of certificates of title for snowmobiles and
8	ATV's and from the issuance of vintage snowmobile
9	permits;
10	(ii) all revenue from the sale of any publications
11	or services relating to snowmobiles and ATV's; [and]
12	(iii) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed
13	and collected as a result of enforcement activities
14	conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
15	under this chapter[.] related to violations attributed to
16	ATV's shall be deposited in the ATV Management Fund <
17	RESTRICTED ACCOUNT;
18	(iv) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed
19	and collected as a result of enforcement activities
20	conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
21	under this chapter related to violations attributed to
22	snowmobiles shall be deposited in the Snowmobile
23	Management Fund;
24	(v) all moneys existing in the restricted account at
25	the time this section becomes effective shall be divided
26	into the two funds based on the current number of active
27	<pre>snowmobile and active ATV registrations; and RESTRICTED <</pre>
28	ACCOUNT;
29	(V) ALL UNOBLIGATED MONEYS IN THE RESTRICTED ACCOUNT
30	EXISTING UNDER THIS SECTION AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF

1	THIS SUBPARAGRAPH SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO THE TWO
2	RESTRICTED ACCOUNTS BASED ON THE CURRENT NUMBER OF ACTIVE
3	SNOWMOBILE AND ACTIVE ATV REGISTRATIONS; AND
4	(vi) all refunds of gas taxes generated under
5	section 9017(d.1) (relating to refunds) shall be
6	deposited in the respective funds TWO RESTRICTED ACCOUNTS <

9	(2) The department shall draw moneys from the <u>respective</u>
10	<pre>funds in the restricted [account] ACCOUNTS for use in</pre> <
11	performing any activities necessary to carry out the purposes
12	of this chapter, including registration and certificate of
13	title activities, training, education, enforcement
14	activities, construction and maintenance of snowmobile and
15	ATV trails and acquisition of equipment, supplies and
16	interests in land. All moneys deposited in [this account <

- 1 (b) Grant-in-aid.--The department shall, upon written
- 2 application and subsequent approval, grant money from the
- 3 appropriate fund of the restricted account RESTRICTED [ACCOUNT] <--

- 5 (1) To municipalities [and], profit and nonprofit organizations in connection with snowmobile and ATV use on
- 7 lands not owned by the Commonwealth for the following:
 - (i) Plans, specifications and engineering surveys.
- 9 (ii) Fees and costs related to the preparation or 10 performance of right-of-way lease agreements.
- 11 (iii) Land acquisition.
- 12 (iv) Construction, maintenance and rehabilitation of 13 trails and other facilities for snowmobiles and ATV's.
- 14 (2) To municipalities and profit and nonprofit
 15 organizations for equipment, training and education
 16 activities relating to snowmobile and ATV use.
- 17 (3) To profit and nonprofit organizations for the

 18 maintenance [and], rehabilitation[, but not the] and

 19 construction[,] of snowmobile and ATV trails on land owned by

 20 the Commonwealth.
- 21 (b.1) Regulations.--No later than 60 days from the effective
- 22 <u>date of this subsection, the department shall promulgate</u>
- 23 <u>regulations necessary to implement the provisions of subsection</u>
- 24 (b). The department shall promulgate the regulations in a manner
- 25 that is separate from regulations pertaining to any other grant
- 26 program administered by the department. The department's
- 27 regulations shall include a quarterly SEMIANNUAL approval grant <--
- 28 process.
- 29 (c) Audit of moneys.--The restricted [account] ACCOUNTS <--
- 30 shall be audited every two years. Copies of the audit shall be

- 1 provided to the Snowmobile and ATV Advisory Committee[.], the
- 2 Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations
- 3 Committee of the House of Representatives. Copies shall also be
- 4 posted and maintained on the department's publicly accessible

- 28 (b) Composition. -- The committee shall consist of 17 members.
- 29 The members shall be as follows:
- 30 (1) The chairman and minority chairman of the

- 1 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the Senate.
- 2 (2) The chairman and minority chairman of the
- 3 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the House of
- 4 Representatives.
- 5 (3) One member [from] <u>representing</u> the Pennsylvania Game 6 Commission.
- 7 (4) One member [from] <u>representing</u> the Allegheny 8 National Forest.
- 9 (5) One member [from] <u>representing</u> the Pennsylvania 10 State Association of Township Supervisors.
- 11 (6) One member [from] <u>representing</u> the Pennsylvania 12 State Association of Boroughs.
- 13 (7) One member [from] <u>representing</u> the Pennsylvania 14 State Association of County Commissioners.
- 15 (7.1) One member representing the Department of

 16 Community and Economic Development.
- 17 (8) [Eight] <u>Seven</u> members of the public representing the 18 following organizations to be appointed by the Secretary of 19 Conservation and Natural Resources:
- 20 (i) Two members from a list of at least six
 21 representatives submitted by the Pennsylvania State
 22 Snowmobile Association.
- (ii) Two members from a list of at least six
 representatives submitted by the Pennsylvania Off-Highway
 Vehicle Association.
- 26 (iii) One member from a list of at least three 27 representatives submitted by the Pennsylvania Farm 28 Bureau.
- [(iv) Two members from a list of at least six representatives submitted by conservation or nonmotorized

- 1 recreation organizations.]
- 2 (v) One member from a list of at least three
- 3 representatives submitted by the Pennsylvania <u>Association</u>
- 4 <u>of Travel [Council] and Tourism.</u>
- 5 (vi) One member from a list of at least three
- 6 representatives submitted by the Pennsylvania Economic
- 7 <u>Development Association.</u>
- 8 Each member may designate an alternate to serve in his stead. A
- 9 member shall notify the chairman in writing of this designation.

- 11 (e) Meetings and expenses.--
- 12 (1) The committee shall meet at least [annually]
- 13 <u>biannually</u>.
- 14 (2) A public member, including a designee, who misses
- three consecutive meetings without good cause [acceptable to
- the chairman] may be replaced by the Secretary of
- 17 Conservation and Natural Resources upon recommendation of the
- 18 chairman.

- 20 (f) Powers and duties. -- The powers and duties of the
- 21 committee shall be to advise the Secretary of Conservation and
- 22 Natural Resources on matters concerning the implementation of
- 23 this chapter, including existing and proposed regulations,
- 24 standards, policies, <u>quidelines</u> and practices; use and operation
- 25 of snowmobiles and ATV's on public and private land;
- 26 acquisition, construction, development and maintenance of
- 27 trails; enforcement; and allocation of fees collected by the
- 28 department pursuant to this chapter.

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- 1 (D.1) MOTORIZED RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.--
- 2 (1) WHEN THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS CHAPTER HAS BEEN PAID
- 3 AND THE FUEL ON WHICH THE TAX HAS BEEN IMPOSED HAS BEEN
- 4 CONSUMED IN THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED RECREATIONAL VEHICLES
- 5 ON DESIGNATED ROADS AND BRIDGES OF THIS COMMONWEALTH,
- 6 INCLUDING ROADS AND BRIDGES BORDERING ON THIS COMMONWEALTH,
- 7 ANNUALLY UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$1,000,000 OF THE FULL AMOUNT OF
- 8 SUCH TAXES SHALL BE REFUNDED TO THE RESTRICTED ACCOUNT
- 9 ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 7706 (RELATING TO RESTRICTED [ACCOUNT]
- 10 ACCOUNTS) UPON PETITION TO THE BOARD OF FINANCE AND REVENUE.
