AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- related offenses, providing for the offense of use of live
- 4 animals in traveling exhibitions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5511.4. Use of live animals in traveling exhibitions.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- No person who is an exhibitor may
- 11 employ or use any exotic animal or exotic wildlife in an animal
- 12 act, ride, performance or exhibition as part of a traveling show
- 13 or exhibition if, during the 15-day period preceding the
- 14 employment or use, the animal was living or traveling in a
- 15 mobile housing facility.
- 16 (b) Applicability. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to the
- 17 <u>use of an animal, including a nonhuman primate:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) in an exhibition at a nonmobile, permanent</u>
- 19 institution or facility, including an accredited zoo or

- 1 <u>aquarium;</u>
- 2 (2) as part of an outreach program for educational or
- 3 conservation purposes by a zoo or aquarium accredited by the
- 4 Association of Zoos and Aquariums, if the animal used for
- 5 <u>such purposes is not kept in a mobile housing facility for</u>
- 6 <u>more than 12 hours per day;</u>
- 7 (3) by a university, college, laboratory or other
- 8 <u>research facility registered with the United States Secretary</u>
- 9 <u>of Agriculture under section 6 of the Animal Welfare Act</u>
- 10 (Public Law 89-544, 7 U.S.C. § 2136); or
- 11 (4) in film, television or advertising, if the use does
- 12 <u>not involve a live public exhibition.</u>
- (c) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 14 <u>misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 15 <u>(d) Definitions.--The following words and phrases when used</u>
- 16 <u>in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this</u>
- 17 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Domestic animal." The term includes, but is not limited to,
- 19 a dog, cat, equine animal, bovine animal, rabbit, sheep, goat or
- 20 porcine animal. The term does not include an exotic animal or
- 21 exotic wildlife.
- 22 "Domestic fowl." An avis raised for food, hobby or sport.
- 23 "Exhibitor." A person who exhibits an animal to the public
- 24 for compensation. The term includes, but is not limited to, the
- 25 owner and operator of a carnival, circus, fair or zoo that
- 26 exhibits an animal, whether for profit or not. The term does not
- 27 include:
- 28 (1) the owner or operator of a retail pet store;
- 29 (2) a person who owns a common, domesticated household
- 30 pet and who derives less than a substantial portion of income

- 1 <u>from a nonprimary source for exhibiting an animal that</u>
- 2 <u>exclusively resides at the residence of the person; or</u>
- 3 (3) an organization that sponsors or a person who
- 4 participates with domestic animal or domestic fowl species in
- 5 <u>a purebred dog or cat show, or a state or county fair or </u>
- 6 <u>livestock show intended to advance the agricultural arts and</u>
- 7 sciences.
- 8 "Exotic animal." An animal that is native to a foreign
- 9 country or of foreign origin or character, is not native to the
- 10 United States or was introduced from abroad and includes all
- 11 hybrids of such animal. The term includes, but is not limited
- 12 to, a nonhuman primate, lion, tiger, leopard, elephant, camel,
- 13 <u>antelope</u>, <u>anteater</u>, <u>kangaroo</u>, <u>water buffalo and any species of</u>
- 14 foreign domestic cattle, such as ankole, gayal and yak.
- 15 <u>"Exotic wildlife."</u> As defined in 34 Pa.C.S. § 2961 (relating
- 16 to definitions).
- 17 "Mobile housing facility." A transporting vehicle,
- 18 including, but not limited to, a truck, trailer or railway car
- 19 used to house animals while traveling for exhibition or public
- 20 education purposes.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
