19	Section 1. The act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known

22	CHAPTER 13
23	PUNITIVE DAMAGES STUDY
24	Section 1301. Duty of commissioner.
25	The commissioner shall study the amount of punitive damages

- 1 paid by physicians, long-term care nursing facilities licensed
- 2 by the Department of Health and personal care homes licensed by
- 3 the Department of Human Services practicing in this Commonwealth
- 4 <u>since March 20, 2005. State agencies shall cooperate with the</u>
- 5 <u>commissioner as necessary to obtain this information.</u>
- 6 <u>Section 1302.</u> Completion of study and updates.
- 7 The commissioner must complete the study one year after this
- 8 chapter takes effect.
- 9 Section 1303. Submission.
- 10 The study must be submitted to the following:
- 11 (1) The chairman and minority chairman of the Banking
- 12 <u>and Insurance Committee of the Senate.</u>
- 13 (2) The chairman and minority chairman of the Insurance
- 14 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
