6	Section 1. The definition of "tobacco product" in section
7	6305(k) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
8	amended to read:
9	§ 6305. Sale of tobacco.

11	(k) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
12	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
13	subsection:

15	"Tobacco product." [A cigarette, cigar, pipe tobacco or
16	other smoking tobacco product or smokeless tobacco in any form,
17	manufactured for the purpose of consumption by a purchaser, and
18	any cigarette paper or product used for smoking tobacco.] <u>The</u>

1 <u>term includes:</u>

2	(1) Any product containing, made or derived from tobacco
3	or nicotine that is intended for human consumption, whether
4	smoked, heated, chewed, absorbed, dissolved, inhaled,
5	snorted, sniffed or ingested by any other means, including,
6	but not limited to, a cigarette, a cigar, a little cigar,
7	chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff and snus.
8	(2) Any electronic device that delivers nicotine or
9	other substance to the person inhaling from the device,
10	including, but not limited to, an electronic cigarette, a
11	cigar, pipe and hookah.
12	The term includes any component, part or accessory of such
13	product or electronic device, whether or not sold separately.
14	The term does not include a product that has been approved by
15	the United States Food and Drug Administration for sale as a
16	tobacco cessation product or for other therapeutic purposes
17	where the product is marketed and sold solely for such approved
18	purpose.
