AN ACT

Making appropriations from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry 2 and the Department of Community and Economic Development to 3 provide for the expenses of administering the Workers' 4 Compensation Act, The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act 5 and the Office of Small Business Advocate for the fiscal year 6 7 July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 2015; and making an interfund transfer. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. The sum of \$71,513,000,\$71,966,000, or as much 13 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 14 Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of 15 Labor and Industry for the payment of all salaries, wages and 16 other compensation and travel expenses, for contractual services 17 and other expenses necessary for the administration of the act 18 of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' 19 Compensation Act, and the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, 20 No. 284), known as The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and for the payment of 21 bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal 22

- 1 year ending June 30, 2015.
- 2 Section 2. The sum of \$194,000 is hereby appropriated from
- 3 the restricted revenue account within the Workmen's Compensation
- 4 Administration Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate in
- 5 the Department of Community and Economic Development as provided
- 6 in the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the
- 7 Workers' Compensation Act, for the operation of that office for
- 8 the fiscal year July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016.
- 9 Section 3. For the purposes of further maintaining the
- 10 Uninsured Employers Guaranty Fund, the sum of \$5,000,000 is
- 11 hereby transferred to the fund from the Workmen's Compensation
- 12 Administration Fund under section 446 of the Workers'
- 13 Compensation Act.
- 14 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, or
- 15 immediately, whichever is later.
