## AN ACT

- Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in restructuring of electric utility 2 industry, further providing for additional alternative energy 3 sources; and abrogating or repealing provisions relating to 5 the production of electrical power from biologically derived methane gas. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 2814 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania 10 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 11 § 2814. Additional alternative energy sources. \* \* \* 12 (d) Biologically derived methane gas. -- Notwithstanding any

- 14 other law, the commission may not limit the nameplate capacity
- and the production of electrical power from biologically derived 15
- methane gas, including methane from the anaerobic digestion of 16
- 17 organic materials from yard waste, such as grass clippings and
- 18 leaves, food waste, animal waste and sewage sludge and landfill
- 19 methane gas.

- 1 Section 2. Any limit of the nameplate capacity and the
- 2 production of electrical power from biologically derived methane
- 3 gas in effect on the effective date of this section, imposed by
- 4 regulation or under the act of November 30, 2004 (P.L.1672,
- 5 No.213), known as the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards
- 6 Act, is abrogated or repealed.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
