## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in culpability, providing for failure
- to report violent offense by witnesses; and imposing a
- 4 penalty.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 306.1. Failure to report violent offense by witnesses.
- 10 (a) General rule.--A person who witnesses the actual
- 11 commission of a violent offense shall, to the extent that the
- 12 person can do so without danger to himself or others, report the
- 13 violent offense to law enforcement as soon as reasonably
- 14 possible.
- 15 (b) Method of notification. -- The duty to notify under this
- 16 section is met if a person notifies or attempts to provide law
- 17 enforcement the notice by telephone or any other means as soon
- 18 as reasonably possible.
- 19 (c) Penalty. -- A person who fails to provide notification as

- 1 required by subsection (a) commits a misdemeanor of the third
- 2 degree.
- 3 (d) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "violent
- 4 <u>offense" means any of the following:</u>
- 5 (1) Murder of the first, second or third degree.
- 6 (2) Voluntary manslaughter.
- 7 (3) Aggravated assault as defined in section 2702(a)(1)
- 8 or (2) (relating to aggravated assault).
- 9 <u>(4) Rape.</u>
- 10 (5) Involuntary deviate sexual intercourse.
- 11 (6) Aggravated indecent assault.
- 12 <u>(7) Incest.</u>
- 13 <u>(8) Sexual assault.</u>
- 14 (9) Arson as defined in section 3301(a) (relating to
- arson and related offenses).
- 16 <u>(10) Kidnapping.</u>
- 17 (11) Burglary as defined in section 3502 (relating to
- burglary).
- 19 (12) An attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to commit
- any of the offenses listed in this subsection.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
