## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in revenues, further providing for transfers from
- 3 State Gaming Fund.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1408(c) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1408. Transfers from State Gaming Fund.

- 10 (c) Local law enforcement grants. -- Annually, the sum of
- 11 [\$2,000,000] \$5,000,000 shall be transferred to the board for
- 12 the purpose of issuing grants to local law enforcement agencies
- 13 [to investigate violations of and enforce laws relating to
- 14 unlawful gambling in this Commonwealth.] as follows:
- 15 (1) The board shall allocate \$2,000,000 for grants to
- 16 local law enforcement agencies to investigate violations of
- and enforce laws relating to unlawful gambling in this
- 18 <u>Commonwealth.</u> For purposes of this [subsection] <u>paragraph</u>,

- 1 the term "local law enforcement agency" shall include the
- 2 Pennsylvania State Police when conducting unlawful gambling
- 3 enforcement and prevention activities in a municipality which
- 4 does not have a municipal police department and in which the
- 5 Pennsylvania State Police provide the municipality with
- 6 primary police coverage.
- 7 (2) The board shall allocate \$3,000,000 for grants to
- 8 <u>local law enforcement agencies in cities of the second class</u>
- 9 A and cities of the third class for public safety initiatives
- and other law enforcement programs.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
