8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 106 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
11	No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended to
12	read:
13	Section 106. Publication of Notices, etc.; Proofs of
14	Publication(a) Whenever, under the provisions of this act,
15	notice is required to be published in one newspaper, such
16	publication shall be made as follows:
17	(1) in a newspaper of general circulation [as defined by the
18	"Newspaper Advertising Act" of May sixteen, one thousand nine
19	hundred twenty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 1784), printed in the county,
20	unless the matter in connection with which the advertising is

being done affects only a school district, in which case such 1 2 advertisement shall be published in a newspaper printed in such 3 school district, if there is such a newspaper, and if not, then in a newspaper circulating generally in such school district. If 4 such notice is required to be published in more than one 5 newspaper, it shall be published in at least one newspaper of 6 general circulation, defined as aforesaid, printed, if there be 7 8 such a newspaper, or circulating generally, as above provided, in the school district. 9

10 When such notice relates to any proceeding or matter in (b) any court, or the holding of an election for the increase of 11 12 indebtedness, or the issue and sale of bonds to be paid by 13 taxation, such notice, in each school district, shall also be 14 published in the legal newspaper, if any, designated by the 15 rules of court of the proper county for the publication of legal 16 notices and advertisements: Provided, That auditors' statements, summaries of auditors' statements, advertisements inviting 17 18 proposals for public contracts and for bids for materials and 19 supplies, or lists of delinquent taxpayers, shall be published 20 only in newspapers of general circulation, defined as 21 aforesaid.] in which the school district is located; 22 (2) in a legal newspaper designated by the rules of court of 23 the county in which the school district is located for the 24 publication of legal notices and advertisements; 25 (3) on the official, public Internet website of a newspaper listed in paragraph (1) or (2), using HTML format or an 26 equivalent language format; or 27 28 (4) in a locally circulated printed publication that is at 29 least four pages long, is issued on at least a weekly basis and

30 is distributed by audited carriers to all known addresses within

a political subdivision. 1

2 (b.1) If notice is required to be published in more than one 3 publication, the publication shall be made by at least two of the means of publication listed in subsection (a). 4 5 (b.2) A school district may determine the appropriate means of publication from the means of publication listed in 6 7 subsection (a), unless such notice is required to be published 8 in the legal newspaper, if any, designated by the rules of court of the proper county for the publication of legal notices and 9 10 advertisements. 11 (b.3) Before a school district changes the manner in which 12 the school district publishes notices as required under this 13 act, the school district shall publish on its official, public 14 Internet website a timely notice of the change in manner of publication. 15 16 (b.4) A school district shall maintain a permanent record of notices published on the school district's official, public 17 18 Internet website. The record shall include the text, manner, 19 date and duration of publication of each notice. 20 (c) Proof of publication of any notice required to be given by the posting of handbills or statements shall be made by 21 attaching an original copy of such handbill or statement as 22 23 actually printed and posted to an affidavit made by the person 24 posting such notice. Such affiant shall not be an interested party or an employe of any person or persons interested in the 25 26 subject matter of said notice. His affidavit shall state where and when the notices were posted and [where] the manner in which_ 27 28 the notice was published [in newspapers, as aforesaid]. A 29 printed copy, exactly as published [in said newspaper], shall be securely attached to a similar affidavit of the publisher or his 30 20150SB1027PN1452
