AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), 1 entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 certain public officials including justices and judges of 3 Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 7 General, the Attorney General and certain other State officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent 10 acts," further providing for members of the General Assembly. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 4(d) and (d.1) of the act of September 15 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official Compensation Law, reenacted November 16, 2005 (P.L.385, No.72), 16 17 are amended to read: Section 4. Members of the General Assembly. 18 19 * * * 20 Subsequent annual cost-of-living adjustment for 21 members.--(1) For the 12-month period beginning December 1, 1997, 22

through November 30, [1998, and for each like 12-month period thereafter] 2016, the salary of the members of the General Assembly shall be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to the then current salary amounts. The percentage increase and the new salary amounts shall be determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives prior to the annual effective date of the adjustment and shall be published by them in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within ten days of the date such determination is made.

beginning December 1, 2021, through November 30, 2022, and for each like 12-month period thereafter, the salary of each legislator shall be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to the then current salary amounts. The percentage increase and the new salary amounts shall be determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives prior to

- 5 prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to
- 6 the then current compensation. The percentage increase and
- 7 the new compensation amounts shall be determined jointly by
- 8 the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of House of
- 9 Representatives prior to the annual effective date of the
- 10 adjustment and shall be published in the Pennsylvania
- Bulletin within 20 days immediately prior to each cost-of-
- 12 <u>living increase taking effect.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
