AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1919 (P.L.366, No.179), entitled "An act reorganizing the Department of State Police; creating therein a Bureau of Fire Protection; providing for a State 3 Police Force, and defining the powers and duties of the same, 4 including the enforcement of laws relating to game, fish, forestry, and water supply, and certain other laws, and including the collection of information useful for the 6 7 detection of crime, and the apprehension of criminals; 8 providing for the equipment, maintenance, and transportation 9 of such police; providing for barracks and substations 10 therefor; and prescribing penalties," further providing for 11 Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of June 3, 1919 (P.L.366, 16 No.179), entitled, "An act reorganizing the Department of State Police; creating therein a Bureau of Fire Protection; providing 17 for a State Police Force, and defining the powers and duties of 18 19 the same, including the enforcement of laws relating to game, 20 fish, forestry, and water supply, and certain other laws, and 21 including the collection of information useful for the detection of crime, and the apprehension of criminals; providing for the 22

equipment, maintenance, and transportation of such police;

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- 1 providing for barracks and substations therefor; and prescribing
- 2 penalties, amended October 5, 1967 (P.L.321, No.140), is
- 3 amended to read:
- 4 Section 7. (a) The [Superintendent] Commissioner of the
- 5 Pennsylvania State Police shall be appointed by the Governor for
- 6 a term of four years from the third Tuesday of January next
- 7 following the election of a Governor and until his successor
- 8 shall have been appointed and qualified. The [officers and
- 9 enlisted men] enlisted members of the State Police [Force shall
- 10 receive an increase of one hundred and twenty dollars per annum
- 11 after one year's service, and an additional increase of one
- 12 hundred and twenty dollars per annum during continuous service
- 13 for each of the following three years, and an additional
- 14 increase of sixty dollars per annum during continuous service
- 15 for each of the following two years: | shall be paid as
- 16 prescribed by law: Provided, That this section shall not apply
- 17 to the [Superintendent] <u>Commissioner</u> of the Pennsylvania State
- 18 Police and the deputies, chiefs, statisticians, clerks, experts,
- 19 and other assistants engaged in the work of the Pennsylvania
- 20 State Police who are not enlisted members of the State Police
- 21 Force, and whose compensation under existing law is fixed by the
- 22 [Superintendent] <u>Commissioner</u> of the Pennsylvania State Police
- 23 with the approval of the Governor.
- 24 (b) The Commissioner and deputies shall be qualified by
- 25 training and experience to perform the duties of the office. No
- 26 Commissioner or deputy shall be appointed who has not served at
- 27 <u>least ten years as a certified law enforcement officer employed</u>
- 28 by any of the following:
- 29 (1) The Pennsylvania State Police.
- 30 (2) A police department requiring certification pursuant to

- 1 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to municipal police
- 2 <u>education and training</u>).
- 3 (3) A law enforcement agency of the Federal Government.
- 4 (4) A law enforcement agency of another state where the
- 5 <u>qualifications for certification are equivalent to, or greater</u>
- 6 than, those required in this Commonwealth.
- 7 (c) The required service under subsection (b) may be
- 8 <u>cumulative</u>, and shall include at least five years of service in
- 9 <u>a position of supervision over other law enforcement officers.</u>
- 10 (d) Prior to receiving authorization to access criminal
- 11 history record information maintained by the State Police or any
- 12 other criminal justice agency, the Commissioner and deputies
- 13 shall be trained pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 Subch. D
- 14 (relating to security).
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
