A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 2015 as "Eye Donor Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 2 WHEREAS, Eye donation allows for restoration of sight to
- 3 recipients whose vision has been affected by injury, disease or
- 4 infection; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Corneal transplant is one of the most frequently
- 6 performed human transplant procedures; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Since 1961, more than 1.5 million corneal
- 8 transplants have been performed in the United States, restoring
- 9 sight to men, women and children ranging from nine days of age
- 10 to 103 years of age; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Corneal transplant operations have a national
- 12 success rate of 95%; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Eye donation follows the same process as organ
- 14 donation, and there are no restrictions on who may donate; and
- 15 WHEREAS, There is no substitute for human cornea tissue, and
- 16 the transplant process depends upon the selfless act of eye
- 17 donation; therefore be it
