A RESOLUTION

1 Designating March 31, 2015, as "Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Day"
2 and congratulating Pennsylvania Farm Bureau members for their
3 significant contributions to our Commonwealth and its
4 agricultural industry.

5 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, formerly the
6 Pennsylvania Farmers' Association, was established on November
7 24, 1950, to give farmers and rural residents a strong voice in
8 State government; and

9 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau represents 59,782 farm
10 and rural families in this Commonwealth; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau has 54 county farm
12 bureau organizations active in 65 counties throughout this
13 Commonwealth; and

14 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau has maintained its
15 integral role in developing and implementing legislation and
16 governmental programs having lasting and positive effects on the
17 economic welfare of agriculture and agribusiness in this
18 Commonwealth; and

1 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau has been and continues
2 to be a strong voice for agriculture at the Federal, State and
3 local levels; and

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau and its affiliated
5 charitable organization, the Pennsylvania Friends of Agriculture
6 Foundation, has been and continues to be effective at educating
7 residents of this Commonwealth about modern food and farming
8 practices; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate March 31, 2015, as
10 "Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Day" and congratulate Pennsylvania
11 Farm Bureau members for their significant contributions to our
12 Commonwealth and its agricultural industry.
