## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study
- the cost-effectiveness of consolidating school district
- 3 services and positions in this Commonwealth.
- 4 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has 500 school districts that
- 5 operate independently with respect to governance, budgetary
- 6 matters, procurement of goods and services, staffing and many
- 7 other issues; and
- 8 WHEREAS, A reduction in the number of school district
- 9 services and positions may improve the cost-effectiveness of
- 10 operating the vast public school system in this Commonwealth;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, A comprehensive study on the advantages and
- 13 disadvantages of consolidating these services and positions
- 14 needs to be conducted; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Senate direct the Legislative Budget and
- 16 Finance Committee to conduct a comprehensive study to determine
- 17 the fiscal impact of consolidating the following positions and
- 18 services:

- 1 (i) Superintendents.
- 2 (ii) Business managers.
- 3 (iii) School board pupil transportation services.
- 4 (iv) Solicitors.
- 5 (v) Bus contractors.
- 6 (vi) Food and beverage contractors.
- 7 (vii) Furniture, textbook and school suppliers;
- 8 and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 10 report its findings and recommendations to the Senate no later
- 11 than June 30, 2016.
