A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of May 2015 as "Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) is better known
- 4 as Lou Gehrig's Disease; and
- 5 WHEREAS, ALS is a fatal neurodegenerative disease
- 6 characterized by degeneration of cell bodies of the upper and
- 7 lower motor neurons in the gray matter of the anterior horn of
- 8 the spinal cord; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The initial symptom of ALS is weakness of the
- 10 skeletal muscles, especially those of the extremities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, As ALS progresses, the patient experiences
- 12 difficulty in swallowing, talking and breathing; and
- 13 WHEREAS, ALS eventually causes muscles to atrophy and the
- 14 patient becomes a functional quadriplegic; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Patients with ALS typically remain alert and aware
- 16 of their loss of motor functions and the inevitable outcome of

- 1 continued deterioration and death; and
- 2 WHEREAS, ALS affects military veterans at twice the rate of
- 3 the general population; and
- 4 WHEREAS, ALS occurs in adulthood, most commonly between 40
- 5 and 70 years of age, peaking at about 55 years of age, and
- 6 affects both men and women without bias; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Annually, more than 5,000 new ALS patients are
- 8 diagnosed throughout the nation; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania, there are currently more than 1,000
- 10 individuals who have been formally diagnosed with ALS; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The \$350,000 in State funding the General Assembly
- 12 appropriated for ALS support services in the General
- 13 Appropriation Act of 2014 provided services to more than 900
- 14 constituents and a substantial savings to the State budget and
- 15 taxpayers; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The ALS Association reports that on average,
- 17 patients diagnosed with ALS only survive two to five years from
- 18 the time of diagnosis; and
- 19 WHEREAS, ALS has no known cause, prevention or cure; and
- 20 WHEREAS, "Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Awareness Month"
- 21 increases the public's awareness of ALS patients' circumstances
- 22 and acknowledges the terrible impact this disease has not only
- 23 on patients but on their families as well and recognizes the
- 24 research being done to eradicate this horrible disease;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the Senate of Pennsylvania designate the month
- 27 of May 2015 as "Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Awareness Month"
- 28 in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 29 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 30 the President of the United States, to the presiding officers of

- 1 each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 2 Pennsylvania.
