A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the week of October 11 through 17, 2015, as "Credit Union Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Credit unions are individual, independent
4	cooperatives founded by people working together toward economic
5	advancement, uniting people seeking a way to improve their
6	future; and
7	WHEREAS, Credit unions call for the pooling of personal
8	resources and leadership abilities for the good of the
9	cooperative, provide low-cost financial services to their
10	members, encourage a regular habit of saving so those in need
11	may borrow and foster the desire to repay loans so members may
12	have access to credit when it is required; and
13	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth currently has 449 credit unions
14	empowering people to improve their economic situations by
15	serving the financial needs of 3.8 million members associated
16	through local, State, regional and international organizations
17	sharing the same commitment to serving credit union members; and

WHEREAS, Credit unions encourage and sponsor activities to
promote charitable acts of their members; and
