## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of March 2016 as "American Red Cross Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, On May 21, 1881, Clara Barton founded the American
- 4 Red Cross; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 1900, the Congress of the United States granted
- 6 the American Red Cross a charter, making the volunteer
- 7 organization responsible for providing services to members of
- 8 the armed forces of the United States and relief to disaster
- 9 victims at home and abroad; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Today's American Red Cross is a humanitarian
- 11 organization led by volunteers that provide relief to victims of
- 12 disasters and help people prevent, prepare for and respond to
- 13 emergencies; and
- 14 WHEREAS, For more than a century, the American Red Cross has
- 15 assisted Americans in preventing, preparing and responding to
- 16 large and small disasters; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Just as families and communities depend on the
- 2 American Red Cross in times of need, the American Red Cross
- 3 depends on the support of the American people to help sustain
- 4 the foundation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross strives to prevent and
- 6 alleviate human suffering wherever it is found, to protect life
- 7 and health and to ensure respect for each human being; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross provides services to all
- 9 Americans in need, regardless of nationality, race, religious
- 10 belief, class or political opinion; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Services provided by the American Red Cross promote
- 12 mutual understanding, friendship, cooperation and lasting peace;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2015, volunteers and staff from the
- 15 American Red Cross responded to 2,479 disasters throughout this
- 16 Commonwealth; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In 2015, 7,252 individuals served as volunteers for
- 18 the American Red Cross in this Commonwealth; and
- 19 WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2015, the American Red Cross
- 20 financially assisted 4,111 families across this Commonwealth;
- 21 and
- 22 WHEREAS, Residents of this Commonwealth donated hundreds of
- 23 thousands of units of blood to help save or better the lives of
- 24 their neighbors; and
- 25 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross trained more than 225,000
- 26 people in many different programs Statewide; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Approximately 132,000 individuals were trained in
- 28 first aid, the proper way to perform CPR or the use of an
- 29 automatic external defibrillator; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Approximately 44,000 individuals were trained in

- 1 aquatics and water safety and more than 46,000 individuals were
- 2 trained in emergency preparedness; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In 2015, the Red Cross House, based in Philadelphia,
- 4 housed 353 new families and provided 20,524 nights of shelter
- 5 and served 61,572 meals; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This year's theme is "No More Fire Deaths," with the
- 7 American Red Cross partnering with local fire departments to
- 8 ensure that anyone that needs a working smoke alarm can get one;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The American Red Cross will continue to play a
- 11 valuable role in catastrophic relief, humanitarianism and
- 12 volunteerism during the 21st century; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of March 2016
- 14 as "American Red Cross Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Senate commend the American Red Cross and
- 16 all of its employees and volunteers for their service and
- 17 dedication to the communities and residents of this
- 18 Commonwealth.
