AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
3 special registration plates.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1341(c) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1341. Special registration plates.

10 (c) Organization registration plates.--Upon request by the
11 applicant, the department is authorized to issue organization
12 registration plates. Organization registration plates may be
13 issued for special groups or for special purposes and bear an
14 appropriate designation. Special groups may charge a fee for
15 authorization to request a registration plate bearing the name
16 of the group or a portion AN ABBREVIATION of the group NAME as <--

1 desired by the organization. If the vehicle is licensed to a  
2 business that is not a member of the special group, the  
3 department shall issue the plate as long as the business owner  
4 or officer making application is a member of that group. An  
5 organization registration plate may be used only on a passenger  
6 car or truck, with a registered gross weight of not more than  
7 14,000 pounds, trailer, motorcycle or motor home.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
