AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for certified copies of
3 records; and, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing
4 for reports by police.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 1956(b) and 3751(b)(1) of Title 75 of
8 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 1956. Certified copies of records.

11 (b) State Police reports.--[The]

12 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the fee for
13 a certified Pennsylvania State Police record of investigation
14 of a vehicle accident which the Pennsylvania State Police are
15 authorized by this title to furnish to the public shall be
16 \$22 for each copy of the Pennsylvania State Police full
17 report of investigation.

18 (2) The fee under paragraph (1) shall not be charged to

1 a volunteer fire company.

2 § 3751. Reports by police.

3 * * *

4 (b) Furnishing copies of report.--

5 (1) Police departments shall, upon request, furnish a
6 certified copy of the full report of the police investigation
7 of any vehicle accident to any [person involved in the
8 accident, his attorney or insurer, and to the Federal
9 Government, branches of the military service, Commonwealth
10 agencies, and to officials of political subdivisions and to
11 agencies of other states and nations and their political
12 subdivisions.] of the following:

13 (i) A person involved in the accident and the
14 person's attorney or insurer.

15 (ii) The Federal Government.

16 (iii) Branches of the military service.

17 (iv) Commonwealth agencies.

18 (v) Officials of political subdivisions.

19 (vi) Agencies of other states and nations and the
20 political subdivisions of other states and nations.

21 (vii) Volunteer fire companies.

22 * * *

23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
