AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 2 Statutes, in powers of Department of Transportation and local
 3 authorities, further providing for display of unauthorized
 4 signs, signals or markings.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6125 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
 9 § 6125. Display of unauthorized signs, signals or markings.

11 (e) Agricultural business advertising signs.--The department
 12 on State-designated highways, including intersections with local
 13 highways, shall establish and enforce specifications for the
 14 erection and maintenance of agricultural business advertising
 15 signs, including, but not limited to, signs that advertise local
 16 farm markets and wayside fresh produce stands. In carrying out
 17 its duties under this subsection, the department may not require
 18 the owner of an agricultural business advertising sign to apply

1 for and obtain a permit from the department.

2 Section 2. The regulations set forth at 67 Pa. Code Ch. 445
3 are abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with this act.

4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
