AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 6, 1989 (P.L.169, No.32), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the regulation of storage tanks and tank facilities; imposing additional powers and duties on the Department of Environmental Protection and the Environmental Quality Board; and making an appropriation," in financial provisions, further providing for Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Board., FOR UNDERGROUND STORAGE <--TANK ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP PROGRAM AND FOR UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK POLLUTION PREVENTION PROGRAM. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 703(a) of the act of July 6, 1989 <--13 (P.L.169, No.32), known as the Storage Tank and Spill Prevention 14 Act, is amended to read: SECTIONS 703(A), 710(F) AND 711(F) OF THE ACT OF <--15 JULY 6, 1989 (P.L.169, NO.32), KNOWN AS THE STORAGE TANK AND 16 17 SPILL PREVENTION ACT, ARE AMENDED TO READ: 18 Section 703. Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Board. 19 (a) Establishment of board, appointment and terms. -- There is
- 20 hereby created the Underground Storage Tank Indemnification

- 1 Board which shall consist of ten members. The Insurance
- 2 Commissioner and the Secretary of the Department of
- 3 Environmental Protection shall be ex officio members. Eight
- 4 members shall be appointed [by the Governor,] as follows:
- 5 (1) Six members who shall be persons with particular
- 6 expertise in the management of underground storage tanks.
- 7 Three of these members shall be appointed for terms of four
- 8 years and three shall be appointed for a term of three years.
- 9 The Governor shall appoint [the members,] two members, the
- 10 President pro tempore of the Senate shall appoint one member,
- 11 the Minority Leader of the Senate shall appoint one member,
- 12 <u>the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one</u>
- 13 <u>member and the Minority Leader of the House of</u>
- 14 Representatives shall appoint one member. The appointments
- 15 <u>shall include</u> one each from a list of nominees provided by
- 16 each of the following:
- 17 (i) The Associated Petroleum Industries of Pennsylvania.
- 19 (ii) The Pennsylvania Petroleum Association.
- 20 (iii) The Service Station Dealers and Automotive
- 21 Repair Association of Pennsylvania and Delaware and the
- 22 Petroleum Retailers and Auto Repair Association, Inc.
- 23 (iv) [The Middle Atlantic Truck Stop Operators] A_
- 24 Statewide organization representing fuel retailers and
- food merchants.
- 26 (v) The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, Pennsylvania State
- 27 Grange and Pennsylvania Farmers Union.
- 28 (vi) The Tank Installers of Pennsylvania.
- 29 (2) [One] <u>The Governor shall appoint one</u> local
- 30 government member who shall have knowledge and expertise in

- 1 underground storage tanks. The local government member shall
- 2 be appointed for a term of two years.
- 3 (3) [One] The Governor shall appoint one public member
- 4 who shall not be an owner or operator of storage tanks nor
- 5 affiliated in any way with any person regulated under this
- 6 act. The public member shall be appointed for a term of three
- 7 years.
