## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in school directors, further providing for persons not to be employed by or do business with district and exceptions.
8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 324(a) of the act of March 10, 1949
11	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
12	amended to read:
13	Section 324. Not to be Employed by or do Business with
14	District; Exceptions(a) No school director shall, during the
15	term for which he was elected or appointed, as a private person
16	engaged in any business transaction with the school district in
17	which he is elected or appointed, be employed in any capacity by
18	the school district in which he is elected or appointed, or
19	receive from such school district any pay for services rendered
20	to the district except as provided in this act: Provided, That

one who has served as a school director for two consecutive 1 2 terms, of six years each, may be elected to the position of attorney or solicitor for the board of which he was a member by 3 4 the unanimous vote of all the other members of the board, and, after resigning his office as school director, shall be entitled 5 6 to receive such pay for his services as solicitor as the board of school directors may determine: Provided, however, That a 7 school director may be appointed to the position of secretary to 8 9 the board of a school district of the second class, of which he 10 was a member during the term for which he was elected or 11 appointed upon the unanimous consent of all the other members of 12 the board after resigning his office as school director, and he shall be entitled to receive such pay for his services as 13 14 secretary as the board of school directors shall determine: And provided further, That one who has served as a school director 15 may, after resigning from office as a school director, be 16 elected to the position of teacher by the board of which he was 17 18 a member by a vote of at least two-thirds of all other members 19 of the board and shall be entitled to receive such pay for his 20 services as a teacher as the board of school directors may 21 lawfully determine[.]: And provided further, That one who has 22 served as a school director and meets the requirements of 23 Article X may, after resigning from office as a school director 24 before the announcement of an open superintendent position and after the vacancy on the board of school directors is filled 25 26 under section 315, be elected to the position of superintendent by the board of which he was a member by a majority vote of all\_ 27 members of the board and shall be entitled to receive such pay 28 29 for his services as a superintendent as the board of school directors may lawfully determine. 30

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
