9	Section 1. Section 8(a.1) of the act of October 27, 2014
10	(P.L.2911, No.191), known as the Achieving Better Care by
11	Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act, added
12	November 2, 2016 (P.L.980, No.124), is amended to read:
13	Section 8. Requirements for prescribers.

15	(a.1) Query not required
16	(1) If a patient has been admitted to a licensed health
17	care facility or is in observation status in a licensed
18	health care facility, the prescriber does not need to query
19	the system after the initial query under subsection $(a)(1)$ as

1	long as the patient remains admitted to the licensed health
2	care facility or remains in observation status in a licensed
3	health care facility.
4	(2) If a patient has been prescribed a non-narcotic
5	Schedule V controlled substance, as defined in the act of
6	April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled
7	Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, that treats an
8	epilepsy or seizure disorder, the prescriber does not need to
9	query the system under subsection (a)(1).

11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
