## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in sentencing, providing for sentencing for offenses involving indecent exposure when children present.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 9720.8. Sentencing for offenses involving indecent exposure
10	when children present.
11	The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing, in accordance with
12	section 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for
13	sentencing), shall provide for a sentence enhancement within its
14	guidelines for an offense under 18 Pa.C.S. § 3127 (relating to
15	indecent exposure), where the offense is graded as a misdemeanor
16	of the first degree, specifying variations from the range of
17	sentences applicable based on such aggravating circumstances as:
18	(1) The number of persons present and under 16 years of

1 <u>age.</u>

2	(2) The age of each person present and under 16 years of
3	age.
4	(3) The nature and character of the indecent exposure.
5	Section 2. The addition of 42 Pa.C.S. § 9720.8 shall apply
6	to offenses committed on or after the effective date of this
7	act.

8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
