Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class 2 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in employees' retirement 3 4 system, further providing for exceptions in favor of 5 employees totally and permanently disabled. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1711 of the act of July 28, 1953 10 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 11 12 Section 1711. Exceptions in Favor of Employes Totally and 13 Permanently Disabled. --* * * 14 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of this act, a county employe who is a member of the police force or the fire 15 16 department or is a county detective, sheriff or deputy sheriff may receive a retirement allowance plus a service increment, if 17 18 any, in accordance with the provisions of section 1712, if the county employe incurs a permanent mental or physical impairment 19

in the line of duty that renders the county employe unable to

- 1 perform his or her duties, regardless of age or years of
- 2 <u>service.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
