AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in fees relating to title, registration and  
3 licensing, further providing for exemption of persons,  
4 entities and vehicles from fees.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1901(c) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:  
9 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

11 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No  
12 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any  
13 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to  
14 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the  
15 registration:

17 (16.1) (i) Any person who is permanently disabled and  
18 whose total annual income does not exceed \$19,200. Unless

1 the person who is permanently disabled is physically and  
2 mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the person who  
3 is permanently disabled must be the principal driver of  
4 the vehicle but may from time to time authorize another  
5 person to drive the vehicle on behalf of the person who  
6 is permanently disabled.

7 (ii) For purposes of this paragraph, a "person who  
8 is permanently disabled" means a person who is unable to  
9 engage in substantial gainful activity by reason of a  
10 medically determinable physical or mental impairment that  
11 can be expected to continue indefinitely.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
