## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the practice of professional 2 nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the 3 revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the 5 renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; 6 prescribing penalties and repealing certain laws," further providing for definitions and for registered nurse, clinical 8 nurse specialist, use of title and abbreviation and providing 9 for certified registered nurse anesthetist. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 12 13 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, 14 No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended by 15 adding a clause to read: 16 Section 2. Definitions .-- When used in this act, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings 18 unless the context provides otherwise: 19
- 20 (16) "Certified registered nurse anesthetist" means a

- 1 registered nurse licensed in this Commonwealth who is certified
- 2 by the State Board of Nursing as a certified registered nurse
- 3 anesthetist.
- 4 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 5 Section 3. Registered Nurse, Clinical Nurse Specialist, Use
- 6 of Title and Abbreviation ["R.N." or] "R.N.," "C.N.S." or
- 7 "C.R.N.A."; Credentials; Fraud.--(a) Any person who holds a
- 8 license to practice professional nursing in this Commonwealth,
- 9 or who is maintained on inactive status in accordance with
- 10 section 11 of this act, shall have the right to use the titles
- 11 "nurse" and "registered nurse" and the abbreviation "R.N." No
- 12 other person shall engage in the practice of professional
- 13 nursing or use the titles "nurse" or "registered nurse" or the
- 14 abbreviation "R.N." to indicate that the person using the same
- 15 is a registered nurse, except that the title "nurse" also may be
- 16 used by a person licensed under the provisions of the act of
- 17 March 2, 1956 (1955 P.L.1211, No.376), known as the "Practical
- 18 Nurse Law." No person shall sell or fraudulently obtain or
- 19 fraudulently furnish any nursing diploma, license, record, or
- 20 registration or aid or abet therein.
- 21 (b) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 22 professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the
- 23 requirements under sections 6.2 and 8.5 of this act to be a
- 24 clinical nurse specialist shall have the right to use the title
- 25 "clinical nurse specialist" and the abbreviation "C.N.S." No
- 26 other person shall have that right.
- 27 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), this section shall not
- 28 prohibit the use by a person of a descriptive title for nurse
- 29 assistive personnel. For the purposes of this subsection, the
- 30 term "nurse assistive personnel" shall mean an individual

- 1 providing health care services under the supervision of a
- 2 professional or practical nurse.
- 3 (d) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 4 professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the
- 5 requirements under section 8.8 of this act to be a certified
- 6 registered nurse anesthetist shall have the right to use the
- 7 <u>title "certified registered nurse anesthetist" and the</u>
- 8 abbreviation "C.R.N.A." No other person shall have that right.
- 9 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 10 Section 8.8. Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist;
- 11 Qualifications. -- (a) The board may certify a licensed
- 12 registered nurse as a certified registered nurse anesthetist if
- 13 the nurse satisfies the requirements established by this act.
- 14 Certification of a certified registered nurse anesthetist by the
- 15 board shall expire on the same date as the license of that nurse
- 16 expires. Beginning on the effective date of this section, a
- 17 nurse shall not qualify for initial certification by the board
- 18 unless the nurse holds a master's degree, doctoral degree or
- 19 post-master's certificate from an educational program in nurse
- 20 anesthesia that has been approved by the board and that prepares
- 21 graduates to practice as a certified registered nurse
- 22 anesthetist and:
- 23 (1) holds current national certification as a certified
- 24 registered nurse anesthetist; and
- 25 (2) meets all other board requirements to practice as a
- 26 certified registered nurse anesthetist.
- 27 <u>(b) A registered nurse who does not have a graduate degree</u>
- 28 required under subsection (a) shall be qualified for
- 29 certification as a certified registered nurse anesthetist if
- 30 that nurse:

- 1 (1) meets the educational requirements for certified
- 2 registered nurse anesthetists that were in effect in the
- 3 Commonwealth at the time the nurse completed nurse anesthesia
- 4 <u>educational program; and</u>
- 5 (2) submits evidence of recertification as a certified
- 6 registered nurse.
- 7 (c) As a condition of biennial certificate renewal by the
- 8 board, a certified registered nurse anesthetist must:
- 9 <u>(1) Demonstrate that the nurse holds current national</u>
- 10 recertification from the appropriate national recertifying body
- 11 <u>as recognized by the board.</u>
- 12 (2) Submit a renewal application to the board.
- 13 (3) Pay a renewal fee as set by the board.
- 14 (4) In the two years prior to the certification renewal,
- 15 complete at least thirty (30) hours of continuing education
- 16 approved by the board, as required under section 12.1.
- 17 (d) For certification under this act, a licensed registered
- 18 nurse shall file a board-prepared application with the board and
- 19 pay a fee as established by the board by regulation.
- 20 (e) A certified registered nurse anesthetist practicing in
- 21 this Commonwealth shall maintain a level of professional
- 22 liability coverage as required for a nonparticipating health
- 23 care provider under the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13),
- 24 known as the "Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error
- 25 (Mcare) Act," and shall not be eligible to participate in the
- 26 Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Fund.
- 27 Section 4. The State Board of Nursing shall promulgate
- 28 regulations to implement the amendment or addition of sections
- 29 2(16), 3 and 8.8 of the act within 18 months of the effective
- 30 date of this section.

1 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
