AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled 1 "An act providing for access to public information, for a designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 5 6 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related 7 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in 9 preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; 10 and, in procedure, further providing for exceptions for 11 public records. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The definition of "personal financial 16 information" in section 102 of the act of February 14, 2008 17 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended to 18 read: Section 102. Definitions.

- 2 "Personal financial information." An individual's personal
- 3 credit, charge or debit card information; bank or other
- 4 <u>financial institution</u> account information; bank, credit or
- 5 financial statements; account, routing or PIN numbers; account

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- 6 passwords; forms required to be filed with Federal or State,
- 7 STATE OR LOCAL taxing authorities; employee benefit election
- 8 <u>information</u> and other information relating to an individual's
- 9 personal finances.

- 11 Section 2. Section 708(c) of the act is amended and
- 12 subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 13 Section 708. Exceptions for public records.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (b) Exceptions. -- Except as provided in subsections (c) and
- 16 (d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under
- 17 this act:
- 18 * * *
- 19 (31) An agency's financial institution account numbers,
- 20 routing numbers, credit card numbers and account passwords.
- 21 (c) Financial records. -- The exceptions set forth in
- 22 subsection (b) shall not apply to financial records, except that
- 23 an agency may redact that portion of a financial record
- 24 protected under subsection (b) (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (16)
- 25 [or], (17) or (31). An agency shall not disclose the identity of
- 26 an individual performing an undercover or covert law enforcement
- 27 activity.

- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
