AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 588 over
2 Interstate 376, Chippewa Township, Beaver County, as the TFC
3 Blake T. Coble Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. TFC Blake T. Coble Memorial Bridge.

7 (a) Findings and declarations.--The General Assembly finds
8 and declares:

9 (1) Trooper First Class Blake T. Coble, a member of the
10 Pennsylvania State Police, passed away in the line of duty at
11 the age of 47, on October 4, 2012.

12 (2) Born in Pittsburgh on November 15, 1964, Trooper
13 First Class Coble was the son of Tom and Judy Clegg Coble.

14 (3) Trooper First Class Coble was a member of the
15 Pennsylvania State Police for more than 24 years, and he had
16 been attached to the Brighton Township Barracks for nearly 20

1 years.

2 (4) A beloved family member, dedicated police officer
3 and avowed community steward, Trooper First Class Coble
4 exemplified the best qualities of the human experience. He
5 generously gave of his heart and time to enhance the quality
6 of life of his family and community.

7 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 588 over
8 Interstate 376 in Chippewa Township, Beaver County, is hereby
9 designated the TFC Blake T. Coble Memorial Bridge.

10 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
11 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
12 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

13 Section 2. Effective date.

14 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
