AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in charter schools, further providing 5 for funding for charter schools and for establishment of 6 cyber charter schools. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1725-A(a)(1) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to 13 read: 14 Section 1725-A. Funding for Charter Schools. -- (a) Funding for a charter school shall be provided in the following manner: 15 (1) [There] Except as provided in subsection (a.1), there 16 17 shall be no tuition charge for a resident or nonresident student attending a charter school. 18 19

(a.1) If the student's school district or intermediate unit

- 1 operates a cyber charter school and the student attends another
- 2 cyber charter school, neither the Commonwealth nor the school
- 3 <u>district shall be required to provide funding under this</u>
- 4 section. The student may be charged tuition by the cyber charter
- 5 school under section 2561.

- 7 Section 2. Section 1745-A(a) of the act is amended to read:
- 8 Section 1745-A. Establishment of cyber charter school.
- 9 (a) Establishment.--A cyber charter school may be
- 10 established by <u>a school entity;</u> an individual; one or more
- 11 teachers who will teach at the proposed cyber charter school;
- 12 parents or guardians of students who will enroll in the cyber
- 13 charter school; a nonsectarian college, university or museum
- 14 located in this Commonwealth; a nonsectarian corporation not-
- 15 for-profit as defined in 15 Pa.C.S. § 5103 (relating to
- 16 definitions); a corporation, association or partnership; or any
- 17 combination of the foregoing. Section 1327.1 shall not apply to
- 18 a cyber charter school established under this subdivision.

- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
