- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1517 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1517. Medical Advisory Board.
- 9 (a) Membership. -- There shall be a Medical Advisory Board
- 10 consisting of [13] members appointed by the secretary. The board
- shall be composed of an authorized representative from the 11
- Department of Transportation, Department of Justice, Governor's 12
- Council on Drug and Alcohol Abuse, Department of Health, 13
- 14 Pennsylvania State Police and professionals as follows: One
- 15 neurologist, one doctor of cardiovascular disease, one doctor of
- 16 internal medicine, one general practitioner, one
- ophthalmologist, one psychiatrist, one orthopedic surgeon [and],_ 17
- one optometrist and one certified driving rehabilitation 18

- 1 <u>specialist</u>.
- 2 (b) Duties. -- The board may advise the department and review
- 3 regulations proposed by the department concerning physical and
- 4 mental criteria including vision standards relating to the
- 5 licensing of drivers under the provisions of this chapter.
- 6 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section the term "certified
- 7 <u>driving rehabilitation specialist" means an individual who</u>
- 8 plans, develops, coordinates and implements driver
- 9 <u>rehabilitation services for individuals with disabilities and is</u>
- 10 certified by a national organization that assesses knowledge and
- 11 skills in the services.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
