AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in grounds and buildings, providing for a prototypical school facility design clearinghouse. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read: 11 12 Section 732.2. Prototypical School Facility Design 13 Clearinghouse. -- (a) (1) The Department of Education shall 14 establish a central clearinghouse of prototypical school 15 facility designs for access by school entities. 16 (2) In order to receive the State reimbursement factor 17 provided for in section 2574, a school entity must use a
- 20 from participating in the program for a particular project, if

(3) The Department of Education may exempt a school entity

prototype design in the construction of school facilities.

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- 1 the school entity demonstrates that:
- 2 (i) the designs in the clearinghouse are not feasible for
- 3 <u>that particular project due to specific geographic or other</u>
- 4 limitations of that area; or
- 5 (ii) the project involves remodeling, rehabilitating or
- 6 <u>expanding an existing structure.</u>
- 7 The Department of Education shall provide notice to a school
- 8 <u>entity that is exempt from using a design in the clearinghouse</u>
- 9 <u>under this paragraph. The notice shall also be made available to</u>
- 10 the public by the school entity.
- 11 (4) The Department of Education shall compile necessary
- 12 publications and a computer database to make the information on
- 13 prototype designs available for review to school entities and
- 14 the public at large.
- 15 (5) For purposes of this section, the Department of
- 16 Education shall divide this Commonwealth into the following
- 17 regions: northwest, northeast, southwest, north
- 18 central and south central. The Department of Education shall
- 19 <u>designate which counties are in which region by grouping</u>
- 20 counties together based on geographic proximity.
- 21 (b) Design professionals registered in this Commonwealth may
- 22 submit plans for inclusion in the computer database that have
- 23 been submitted and approved by the Department of Education in
- 24 accordance with section 731. The original design professional of
- 25 record shall retain ownership of a prototype design.
- 26 Prototypical school facility designs submitted shall include
- 27 <u>information that the Department of Education determines is</u>
- 28 necessary and appropriate to facilitate this section.
- 29 (c) The Department of Education shall review and evaluate
- 30 plans submitted pursuant to this section for inclusion in the

- 1 clearinghouse using standards which promote the following:
- 2 (1) The use of design principles to achieve the highest
- 3 standards of health, safety, accessibility, environmental
- 4 protection and energy efficiency.
- 5 (2) The academic and technological needs of students.
- 6 (3) The use of cost-effective design and construction
- 7 techniques, including the use of straight-line, right-angle
- 8 <u>design principles and avoiding the use of curved and</u>
- 9 <u>nonsymmetrical design.</u>
- 10 (4) The use of design principles that allow for expansion of
- 11 <u>school facilities to accommodate future growth in student</u>
- 12 population.
- 13 <u>(5) The use of durable materials in construction.</u>
- 14 (6) The preservation of open space.
- 15 (d) The Department of Education shall group the designs
- 16 accepted for the clearinghouse by the regions established under
- 17 subsection (a) (5), based on energy needs for heating and
- 18 cooling, building size, average school entity population in the
- 19 region, layout of the building, whether one story or multiple
- 20 stories, and structural requirements due to climatic or
- 21 geographic difficulties.
- 22 (e) The Legislative Budget and Finance Committee shall
- 23 conduct a study of the program to determine the savings incurred
- 24 by school entities that have participated in the program. The
- 25 study shall be conducted at the conclusion of the fifth year of
- 26 operation and shall include program participation for the five-
- 27 year period from inspection until its fifth anniversary. The
- 28 study shall be presented within six months of its commencement
- 29 to the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Education
- 30 Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority

- 1 <u>chairperson of the Education Committee of the House of</u>
- 2 Representatives.
- 3 (f) The Department of Education shall adopt rules necessary
- 4 to implement this section.
- 5 (q) As used in this section, the term "school entity" means
- 6 <u>a school district, intermediate unit, area vocational-technical</u>
- 7 <u>school or charter school operating within this Commonwealth</u>
- 8 under the provisions of this act.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
