Designating a portion of State Route 1001 in Greene Township, Franklin County, as the Lance Corporal Michael L. Freeman, Jr., Memorial Highway-; DESIGNATING A BRIDGE ON THAT PORTION <--3 OF STATE ROUTE 533 OVER MUDDY RUN, SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, AS THE PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DANA EDWARD DIEHL MEMORIAL BRIDGE; AND DESIGNATING A BRIDGE ON THAT PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 1004 OVER THE CONOCOCHEAGUE CREEK, GREENE 7 TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, AS THE PRIVATE CHARLES W. "BILL" 8 ROHER MEMORIAL BRIDGE. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Lance Corporal Michael L. Freeman, Jr., Memorial 13 Highway. Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as 14 15 follows: 16 Lance Corporal Michael L. Freeman, Jr., of 17 Fayetteville, died while supporting combat operations in Helmand Province, Afghanistan, on February 1, 2010, paying 18 the supreme sacrifice for his nation in Operation Enduring 19

- 2 (2) A 2008 graduate of Chambersburg Area High School,
- 3 Lance Corporal Freeman had served in the Marine Corps since
- 4 August 2008.
- 5 (3) Lance Corporal Freeman, a machine gunner assigned to
- 6 2nd Battalion, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary
- Force in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, had been on his first
- 8 deployment in Afghanistan since October 2009.
- 9 (4) Lance Corporal Freeman was awarded the Purple Heart,
- 10 Combat Action Ribbon and the Afghanistan Campaign Medal.
- 11 (b) Designation. -- The section of State Route 1001 from
- 12 Memorial Road to Mt. Pleasant Road in Greene Township, Franklin
- 13 County, is designated the Lance Corporal Michael L. Freeman,
- 14 Jr., Memorial Highway.
- 15 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 16 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to

- 18 SECTION 2. PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DANA EDWARD DIEHL MEMORIAL
- 19 BRIDGE.
- 20 (A) FINDINGS. -- THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES AS
- 21 FOLLOWS:
- 22 (1) PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DANA EDWARD DIEHL, A NATIVE OF
- 23 SHIPPENSBURG, LIVED MOST OF HIS LIFE A FEW MILES FROM THE
- 24 BRIDGE OVER MUDDY RUN. HE CROSSED OVER THE BRIDGE ON SUNDAY
- 25 MORNINGS TRAVELING TO CHURCH, SPENT MANY HOURS FISHING WITH
- 26 HIS FATHER ALONG MUDDY RUN AND COOLED OFF IN THE STREAM WITH
- 27 HIS FAMILY DURING HOT SUMMER DAYS.
- 28 (2) PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DIEHL GRADUATED FROM
- 29 SHIPPENSBURG AREA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN 1967. DURING HIGH
- 30 SCHOOL, HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE WRESTLING TEAM AND ACTIVE IN

- 1 BOY SCOUT TROOP NO. 251.
- 2 (3) PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DIEHL HONORABLY SERVED HIS
- 3 COUNTRY AS A MEDICAL SPECIALIST WITH THE 25TH INFANTRY
- 4 DIVISION, 3RD SQUADRON, 4TH CAVALRY, HEADQUARTERS TROOP.
- 5 (4) ON DECEMBER 10, 1968, IN HAU NGHIA PROVINCE, SOUTH
- 6 VIETNAM, PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DIEHL WAS KILLED WHEN THE
- 7 VEHICLE IN WHICH HE WAS RIDING WAS STRUCK BY AN EXPLOSIVE
- 8 DEVICE.
- 9 (B) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE LOCATED ON STATE ROUTE 533 OVER
- 10 MUDDY RUN IN SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IS
- 11 DESIGNATED THE PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DANA EDWARD DIEHL MEMORIAL
- 12 BRIDGE.
- 13 (C) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
- 14 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE BRIDGE TO
- 15 TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS ON THE BRIDGE.
- 16 SECTION 3. PRIVATE CHARLES W. "BILL" ROHER MEMORIAL BRIDGE.
- 17 (A) FINDINGS.--THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES AS
- 18 FOLLOWS:
- 19 (1) PRIVATE CHARLES W. "BILL" ROHER, A NATIVE OF
- 20 CHAMBERSBURG, SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM APRIL 19,
- 21 1943, TO MARCH 28, 1945.
- 22 (2) PRIVATE CHARLES W. "BILL" ROHER WAS A HIGHLY
- 23 DECORATED VETERAN OF WORLD WAR II, HAVING EARNED THE PURPLE
- 24 HEART, BRONZE STAR, COMBAT INFANTRY BADGE, WORLD WAR II
- 25 VICTORY MEDAL, AMERICAN CAMPAIGN MEDAL, EUROPEAN THEATER OF
- 26 WAR RIBBON WITH ONE STAR, GOOD CONDUCT MEDAL, MARKSMAN BADGE
- 27 WITH RIFLE BAR AND GLIDER BADGE.
- 28 (B) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE ON STATE ROUTE 1004 OVER THE
- 29 CONOCOCHEAGUE CREEK IN GREENE TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IS
- 30 DESIGNATED THE PRIVATE CHARLES W. "BILL" ROHER MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

- 1 (C) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
- 2 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE BRIDGE TO
