7	Section 1. Section 9125(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 9125. Use of records for employment.

11	(b) Use of information
12	(1) Felony and misdemeanor convictions may be considered
13	by the employer only to the extent to which they relate to
14	the applicant's suitability for employment in the position
15	for which he has applied.
16	(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1):
17	(i) No employer may request from or consider
18	criminal history background information relating to an
19	applicant for employment, regardless of the grading of

1	the offense, which has been expunged according to law.
2	(ii) No employer may refuse to hire an applicant for
3	employment or take discipline or adverse action against
4	an employee solely on the basis that the applicant or
5	employee represented to the employer that the applicant
6	or employee was not convicted of an offense if, at the
7	time of the representation, the criminal history record
8	information relating to the offense has been expunged
9	according to law.

11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
