1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for higher education accountability and transparency.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an
11	article to read:

15	Section 2001-H. Definitions.
16	The following words and phrases when used in this article
17	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
18	context clearly indicates otherwise:

1	"COLLEGE NAVIGATOR WEBSITE." THE COLLEGE NAVIGATOR WEBSITE <-
2	OR ITS SUCCESSOR WEBSITE OPERATED BY THE UNITED STATES
3	DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND REQUIRED PURSUANT TO 20 U.S.C. §
4	1015A (RELATING TO TRANSPARENCY IN COLLEGE TUITION FOR
5	CONSUMERS).
6	"Department." The Department of Education of the
7	Commonwealth.
8	"Graduation rates." The percentages of full-time
9	undergraduate students enrolled for credit toward a degree,
10	diploma, certificate or other formal credential who are awarded
11	a degree, diploma or certificate within each of the following:
12	(1) 100% of the normal completion time for the student's
13	program.
14	(2) 125% of the normal completion time for the student's
15	program.
16	(3) 150% of the normal completion time for the student's
17	program.
18	"Institution of higher education." The term includes any of
19	the following:
20	(1) A community college operating under Article XIX-A.
21	(2) A university within the State System of Higher
22	Education.
23	(3) The Pennsylvania State University, the University of
24	<u>Pittsburgh, Temple University, Lincoln University or any</u>
25	other institution designated as State-related by the
26	Commonwealth.
27	(4) The Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology.
28	(5) An institution of higher education which is operated
29	not for profit, located in and incorporated or chartered by
30	the Commonwealth and entitled to confer degrees as set forth

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1	in 24 Pa.C.S. § 6505 (relating to power to confer degrees)
2	and is designated as a "college" or "university" as provided
3	for by the standards and qualifications prescribed by the
4	State Board of Education under 24 Pa.C.S. Ch. 65 (relating to
5	private colleges, universities and seminaries).
6	(6) A private school licensed under the act of December
7	15, 1986 (P.L.1585, No.174), known as the Private Licensed
8	Schools Act.
9	"Net tuition and fees." The average total cost of attendance
10	minus the average amount of grant or scholarship aid awarded to
11	<u>a first-time, full-time undergraduate student enrolled for</u>
12	credit toward a degree, diploma, certificate or other formal
13	credential from the Federal Government, the Commonwealth or the
14	institution of higher education.
15	"PHEAA." The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance
16	<u>Agency.</u>

2	AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET

4	MINIMUM, THE FOLLOWING:

6	A DESCRIPTION OF THE USES AND FEATURES OF THE COLLEGE
7	NAVIGATOR WEBSITE.
8	(2) A DIRECT LINK TO THE HIGH PRIORITY OCCUPATIONS
9	PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
10	LABOR AND INDUSTRY WITH A DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HIGH PRIORITY
11	OCCUPATIONS ARE AND HOW THEY ARE IDENTIFIED.
12	(B) DUTY OF PHEAAPHEAA SHALL INCLUDE A LINK ON ITS
13	PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE TO INFORMATION CONTAINED ON
14	THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE UNDER SUBSECTION (A).
15	(C) DUTY OF SCHOOL ENTITIES EACH SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL
16	ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)
17	TO STUDENTS IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE.

2	higher education by the following:
3	(i) Programs of study available.
4	<u>(ii) Name.</u>
5	<u>(iii) Physical address.</u>
6	(iv) Total enrollment for the previous academic
7	year.
8	(v) Net tuition and fees per year based on the
9	previous academic year.
10	(vi) Percentages of students receiving:
11	(A) Pell grants.
12	(B) Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity
13	grants.
14	(C) Academic Competitiveness grants.
15	(D) National Science and Mathematics Access to
16	<u>Retain Talent grants.</u>
17	(E) Teacher Education Assistance for College and
18	<u>Higher Education grants.</u>
19	(vii) Average total debt borrowed for undergraduate
20	<u>study.</u>
21	(viii) Graduation and retention rates, including
22	information on average time, in years, to attainment of a
23	degree, diploma, certificate or other formal credential
24	<u>for a full-time student.</u>
25	<u>(ix) Percentage of undergraduate students who have</u>
26	defaulted on their Federal student loans within three
27	years of entering repayment.
28	(3) Be accessible to the public without requiring
29	registration or use of a user name, password or other user
30	identification.

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1	(4) Include a link to the publicly accessible Internet
2	website of the Department of Labor and Industry and a link to
3	the publicly accessible Internet website of each of the
4	institutions of higher education selected.
5	(5) Include a direct link to the High Priority
6	Occupations publicly accessible Internet website of the
7	Department of Labor and Industry with a description of what
8	high priority occupations are and how they are identified.
9	(c) ChartThe comparison tool required under this section
10	must generate a comparison chart in a grid format that:
11	(1) Lists the institutions of higher education that
12	<u>match a user's search criteria.</u>
13	(2) Provides information for each institution of higher
14	education listed as outlined in subsection (b)(2).
15	(d) Duty of institutionsEach IF THE DEPARTMENT IS <
16	REQUIRED TO DEVELOP THE COMPARISON TOOL UNDER SUBSECTION (A),
17	EACH institution of higher education shall provide the
18	information listed in this section, as available, to the
19	department not later than January 1 of each year. If the
20	information required under this subsection is available in an
21	institution of higher education's Integrated Postsecondary
22	Education Data System report, the institution of higher
23	education may comply with the reporting requirements of this
24	subsection by sending an electronic copy of the Integrated
25	Postsecondary Education Data System report to the department.
26	The department shall update the comparison tool as soon as
27	practicable after receiving information from each institution of
28	higher education.
29	(e) The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency <
30	PHEAA shall include a link on its publicly accessible Internet <
