Section 1327.1 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended by adding a subsection to read: 12 Section 1327.1. Home Education Program. -- * * * 13 (f.2) The school district of residence shall provide access 14 to libraries within the district to students enrolled in a home 15 education program and home education supervisors for the purpose 16 of borrowing scholastic materials. School districts providing <u>library access may designate specific time periods in which</u> 17
- 19 <u>supervisors are permitted to use their facilities. School</u>

students enrolled in home education programs and home education

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- 1 <u>districts providing library access may exclude or may set</u>
- 2 guidelines for use of their facilities by students participating
- 3 <u>in a home education program who have previously been excluded in </u>
- 4 the form of suspension or expulsion, as provided for in 22 Pa.
- 5 Code Ch. 12 (relating to students and student services), from
- 6 <u>any public or private school.</u>
