AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for
3 propulsion of missiles into an occupied vehicle or onto a
4 roadway.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 2707(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 2707. Propulsion of missiles into an occupied vehicle or onto
10 a roadway.

11 (a) Occupied vehicles.--Whoever intentionally throws, shoots
12 or propels a rock, stone, brick, or piece of iron, steel or
13 other like metal, or any deadly or dangerous missile, or fire
14 bomb, into a vehicle or instrumentality of public transportation
15 that is occupied by one or more persons commits a [misdemeanor
16 of the first degree] felony of the third degree.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
