AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of Avenue A over the
2 Allegheny River, Coudersport Borough, Potter County, as the
3 Commander Philip F. "Jet" Palmatier, Jr., Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Commander Philip F. "Jet" Palmatier, Jr., Memorial
7 Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Commander Philip F. "Jet" Palmatier, Jr., was born
11 on November 4, 1950, in Coudersport, graduated with honors
12 from the local high school and was appointed to the United
13 States Naval Academy.

14 (2) On December 10, 1990, Commander Palmatier, a career
15 Navy officer, was flying a training mission over the Gulf of
16 Mexico when his TA-4 Skyhawk collided with another jet,
17 killing Commander Palmatier at 40 years of age.

1 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on Avenue A, bridge ID
2 52400200120000, over the Allegheny River in Coudersport Borough,
3 Potter County, is designated the Commander Philip F. "Jet"
4 Palmatier, Jr., Memorial Bridge.

5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

8 Section 2. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
