AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for persons required to report suspected child abuse.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $6311(a)(16)$ and (b) (1) (iii) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 6311. Persons required to report suspected child abuse.
(a) Mandated reporters.--The following adults shall make a report of suspected child abuse, subject to subsection (b), if the person has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse:

(16) An adult family member who is a person responsible for the child's welfare and provides services to a child in a family living home, community home for individuals with an intellectual disability or host home for children which are subject to supervision or licensure by the department under

Articles IX and $X$ of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the [Public Welfare] Human Services Code. (b) Basis to report.--
(1) A mandated reporter enumerated in subsection (a) shall make a report of suspected child abuse in accordance with section 6313 (relating to reporting procedure), if the mandated reporter has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse under any of the following circumstances:

(iii) [A] The mandated reporter witnesses an abusive act to an identifiable child or a person makes a specific disclosure to the mandated reporter that an identifiable child is the victim of child abuse.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
