Persons required to report suspected child abuse. 10 Mandated reporters. -- The following adults shall make a 11 report of suspected child abuse, subject to subsection (b), if 12 the person has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse: 13 14 15 An adult family member who is a person responsible 16 for the child's welfare and provides services to a child in a 17 family living home, community home for individuals with an intellectual disability or host home for children which are 18 subject to supervision or licensure by the department under 19

(iii) [A] <u>The mandated reporter witnesses an abusive</u>
