7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
9	as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to

13	following shall apply to home-based and community-based services
14	provided to individuals with an intellectual disability or
15	autism:
16	(1) The department shall maintain and publish in the <
17	<u>Pennsylvania Bulletin on or before December 31 of each fiscal</u>

1	year a detailed description of the calculation of providers!
2	payment rates for home based and community based services,
3	including the data, inputs, assumptions, variables, calculations
4	and precise methodologies relied on and the source of all data,
5	variables and assumptions utilized in establishing the payment
6	rates notwithstanding whether the payment rates are developed by
7	the department or a third party. The information shall be made
8	available by the department to each provider, family and
9	consumer for inspection, examination and copying.
10	(2) A provider shall submit cost reports to the department,
11	or the department's designee, on or before September 30 of each
12	fiscal year that identify the costs incurred to render home
13	based and community-based services during the prior fiscal year.
14	This paragraph shall expire October 1, 2020.
15	(1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH IN THE PENNSYLVANIA <
16	BULLETIN ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31 OF EACH YEAR A PUBLIC NOTICE THAT
17	CONTAINS THE PROPOSED PROVIDER PAYMENT RATES FOR THE NEXT FISCAL
18	YEAR SUFFICIENT TO ENABLE INDIVIDUALS WITH AN INTELLECTUAL
19	DISABILITY OR AUTISM, WHO ARE ENROLLED IN ANY OF THE
20	DEPARTMENT'S FEDERALLY APPROVED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FUNDED WAIVER
21	PROGRAMS, TO ACCESS SERVICES WHICH MUST COMPLY WITH THE
22	DEPARTMENT'S QUALITY OF CARE STANDARDS AND ARE NECESSARY TO MEET
23	THE NEEDS OF INDIVIDUALS WITH AN INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY OR
24	AUTISM, AS IDENTIFIED IN THE INDIVIDUALS' APPROVED INDIVIDUAL
25	SUPPORT PLANS.
26	(2) THE NOTICE SHALL SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT ON AND CONTAIN A
27	DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE PRECISE METHODOLOGIES UTILIZED TO
28	CALCULATE THE PAYMENT RATES FOR HOME-BASED AND COMMUNITY-BASED
29	SERVICES TO BE RENDERED UNDER THE WAIVER PROGRAMS, INCLUDING THE
30	DATA, STUDIES, ASSUMPTIONS, VARIABLES, CALCULATIONS AND ANY
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- 1 OTHER INFORMATION RELIED UPON AND THE SOURCE OF ALL INFORMATION
- 2 UTILIZED IN ESTABLISHING THE PAYMENT RATES. THE INFORMATION
- 3 SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR INSPECTION,
- 4 EXAMINATION AND COPYING.
- 5 (3) WITHIN FORTY-FIVE DAYS OF THE PASSAGE OF THE GENERAL
- 6 APPROPRIATION ACT EACH YEAR, AND AFTER REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION_
- 7 OF THE PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE
- 8 DEPARTMENT, BY NOTICE PUBLISHED IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN,
- 9 SHALL ADOPT THE FINAL PROVIDER PAYMENT RATES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
- 10 AND SHALL RESPOND IN DETAIL TO THE PUBLIC COMMENTS.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
