## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

  Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for
- definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for
- suspension of operating privilege; and, in miscellaneous
- 5 provisions, further providing for careless driving.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 10 § 102. Definitions.
- 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 12 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 13 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 14 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 15 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

- 17 <u>"Vulnerable highway user." A pedestrian or a person on</u>
- 18 roller skates, inline skates, a skateboard, motor-driven cycle,
- 19 motorcycle, pedalcycle, motorized pedalcycle, pedalcycle with

- 1 <u>electric assist, an animal, an animal drawn vehicle, a farm</u>
- 2 vehicle or a wheelchair.

- 4 Section 2. Sections 1532(a) and (b)(1) and (5) and 3714 are
- 5 amended to read:
- 6 § 1532. Suspension of operating privilege.
- 7 (a) One-year suspension. -- The department shall suspend the
- 8 operating privilege of any driver for one year upon receiving a
- 9 certified record of the driver's conviction of or an
- 10 adjudication of delinquency based on any of the following
- 11 offenses:
- 12 (1) Any felony in the commission of which a court
- determines that a vehicle was essentially involved.
- 14 (3) Any violation of the following provisions:
- Section 3714(b.1) (relating to careless driving).
- Section 3735.1 (relating to aggravated assault by
- 17 vehicle while driving under the influence).
- 18 Section 3742 (relating to accidents involving death
- or personal injury).
- Section 3742.1 (relating to accidents involving death
- or personal injury while not properly licensed).
- 22 Section 7111 (relating to dealing in titles and
- plates for stolen vehicles).
- 24 Section 7121 (relating to false application for
- certificate of title or registration).

- 29 (b) Suspension.--
- 30 (1) The department shall suspend the operating privilege

- of any driver for six months upon receiving a certified
- 2 record of the driver's conviction of or an adjudication of
- delinquency based on any offense under the following
- 4 provisions:
- 5 Section 3367 (relating to racing on highways).
- 6 Section 3714(b)[(relating to careless driving)] or
- 7 (c.1).
- 8 Section 3734 (relating to driving without lights to
- 9 avoid identification or arrest).
- 10 Section 3736 (relating to reckless driving).
- 11 Section 3743 (relating to accidents involving damage
- to attended vehicle or property).

- 14 (5) The department shall suspend the operating privilege
- of any driver for three months upon receiving a certified
- record of the driver's conviction of or an adjudication of
- delinquency based on section 3714(c) or (c.2).

- 19 § 3714. Careless driving.
- 20 (a) General rule. -- Any person who drives a vehicle in
- 21 careless disregard for the safety of persons or property is
- 22 guilty of careless driving, a summary offense.
- 23 (b) Unintentional death.--[If] Except as provided in
- 24 <u>subsection (b.1)</u>, if the person who violates this section
- 25 unintentionally causes the death of another person as a result
- 26 of the violation, the person shall, upon conviction, be
- 27 sentenced to pay a fine of \$500.
- 28 (b.1) Death involving a vulnerable highway user.--If the
- 29 person who violates this section causes the death of a
- 30 vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation, the person

- 1 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more
- 2 than \$10,000.
- 3 (c) Serious bodily injury. -- [If] Except as provided in
- 4 <u>subsection (c.1), if</u> the person who violates this section
- 5 unintentionally causes the serious bodily injury of another
- 6 person as a result of the violation, the person shall, upon
- 7 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$250.
- 8 (c.1) Serious bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user.--
- 9 If the person who violates this section causes the serious
- 10 bodily injury of a vulnerable highway user as a result of the
- 11 violation, the person shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
- 12 pay a fine of not more than \$5,000.
- 13 (c.2) Bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user.--If a
- 14 person who violates this section causes the bodily injury of a
- 15 vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation, the person
- 16 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more
- 17 than \$1,000.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
