AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in general powers and
- duties, providing for work requirements for the Supplemental
- 5 Nutrition Assistance Program.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 9 as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 10 read:
- 11 <u>Section 216. Work Requirements for the Supplemental</u>
- 12 Nutrition Assistance Program. -- (a) The department may not apply
- 13 for, accept or renew a waiver of requirements established under
- 14 section 6(o) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (Public Law
- 15 <u>88-525</u>, 7 U.S.C. § 2015(o)) without prior approval of the
- 16 <u>General Assembly.</u>
- 17 (b) To the extent permitted by Federal law, as a condition

- 1 of participation and continuing eligibility for food assistance,
- 2 an adult recipient shall comply with and submit proof of
- 3 compliance with at least one of the following:
- 4 (1) The recipient has been employed for an average of at
- 5 <u>least twenty hours per week.</u>
- 6 (2) The recipient engaged in at least twenty-four hours of
- 7 <u>community service per month.</u>
- 8 (3) The recipient participates in a work program for at
- 9 <u>least twenty hours per week.</u>
- 10 (4) The recipient is enrolled as a full-time student in an
- 11 <u>institution of higher education.</u>
- 12 (c) Subsection (b) shall not apply to individuals who are
- 13 exempt under section 6(o)(3) of the Food and Nutrition Act of
- 14 <u>2008 (7 U.S.C. § 2015(o)(3)).</u>
- 15 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO ADULT RECIPIENTS <--
- 16 ON THE DATE OF ANNUAL RENEWAL:
- 17 (1) THAT THE RECIPIENT'S ELIGIBILITY FOR FOOD ASSISTANCE
- 18 WILL BE TERMINATED IF THE RECIPIENT FAILS TO MEET THE
- 19 REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B); AND
- 20 (2) OF LOCATIONS WHERE ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE TO RECIPIENTS
- 21 IN MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B).
- 22 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE ELECTRONICALLY TO COUNTY ASSISTANCE
- 23 OFFICES A FORM NOTICE.
- 24 (E) ELIGIBILITY FOR FOOD ASSISTANCE SHALL BE TERMINATED
- 25 THREE MONTHS AFTER NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (D) IF THE RECIPIENT
- 26 FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B).
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
