Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for 2 injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; 3 establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation 5 thereunder; and prescribing penalties," in liability and compensation, providing for registration of status as 6 independent contractor. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known 12 as the Workers' Compensation Act, is amended by adding a section 13 to read: 14 Section 304.3. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of 15 law THIS ACT, a person may file a registration with the 16 department regarding the status of an individual who is 17 classified for Federal income tax purposes as an independent 18 contractor of the person. 19 (b) A registration under this section shall include the

- 1 (1) A written waiver by the individual of all benefits under
- 2 this act from the person.
- 3 (2) An affidavit by the individual specifying that the
- 4 individual understands AND AGREES that the individual: <--
- 5 <u>(i) is not an employe of the person;</u>
- 6 (ii) is not entitled to benefits under this act from the
- 7 person; and
- 8 <u>(iii) may purchase workers' compensation insurance under</u>
- 9 this act- OR OTHER DISABILITY INSURANCE AT THE INDIVIDUAL'S OWN <--
- 10 EXPENSE; AND
- 11 (IV) IS NOT ENTITLED TO BENEFITS FROM THE UNINSURED
- 12 EMPLOYERS GUARANTY FUND IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS INJURED WHILE
- 13 <u>PERFORMING SERVICES FOR THE PERSON.</u>
- 14 <u>(c) The waiver and affidavit under subsection (b) shall be</u>
- 15 made upon forms prescribed by the department.
- 16 <u>(d) THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:</u>
- 17 (1) A person who registers an individual as an independent
- 18 contractor under this section:
- 19 (I) shall not be liable to the individual for benefits <--

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- 20 under this act; and
- 21 (II) shall not be required to provide insurance coverage <--
- 22 or self-insure under this act regarding the individual.
- 23 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL REGISTERED AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR <--
- 24 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR BENEFITS FROM THE
- 25 UNINSURED EMPLOYERS GUARANTY FUND IF THE PERSON IS INJURED WHILE
- 26 PERFORMING SERVICES AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR PURSUANT TO THE
- 27 REGISTRATION.
- 28 (e) A registration regarding IDENTIFYING an individual as an <--
- 29 <u>independent contractor shall be valid for each future year</u>,
- 30 except that the individual may request that the registration be

- 1 revoked at any time. The following apply:
- 2 (1) The request for revocation shall be on a form prescribed
- 3 by the department.
- 4 (2) The individual shall file the request for revocation
- 5 with the department and CONCURRENTLY provide notice by certified <--
- 6 mail of the filing of the request with the person who filed the
- 7 <u>registration</u>.
- 8 (3) The department shall confirm receipt of the request for
- 9 revocation with the individual and the person WITHIN FIVE DAYS <--
- 10 OF THE RECEIPT OF THE REQUEST.
- 11 (4) The revocation shall be effective ten days after the
- 12 receipt of the request by the department.
- 13 (f) A person may not offer or provide an incentive, <--
- 14 pecuniary or otherwise, for an individual to:
- 15 <u>(1) complete the waiver and affidavit under subsection (b);</u>
- 16 or
- 17 (2) refrain from filing a request for revocation under
- 18 subsection (e).
- 19 (F) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING TO PERSUADE <--
- 20 AN INDIVIDUAL TO COMPLETE THE WAIVER AND AFFIDAVIT UNDER
- 21 SUBSECTION (B) OR REFRAIN FROM FILING A REQUEST FOR REVOCATION
- 22 UNDER SUBSECTION (E):
- 23 (1) KNOWINGLY PROVIDE AN INCENTIVE TO THE INDIVIDUAL,
- 24 PECUNIARY OR OTHERWISE.
- 25 (2) KNOWINGLY PROVIDE MATERIALLY FALSE INFORMATION TO THE
- 26 INDIVIDUAL.
- 27 (3) KNOWINGLY WITHHOLD INFORMATION FROM THE INDIVIDUAL IN
- 28 ORDER TO DECEIVE THE INDIVIDUAL.
- 29 (g) A person violating subsection (f) shall be subject to
- 30 the penalties under FOR AN INTENTIONAL VIOLATION OF section 305. <--

- 1 (h) As used in this section:
- 2 (1) "Independent contractor" includes an individual who
- 3 performs services for a person for valuable consideration but
- 4 who is not classified as an employe of the person for Federal
- 5 <u>income tax purposes.</u>
- 6 (2) "Person" includes a corporation, partnership, limited
- 7 <u>liability company, business trust, other association, government</u>
- 8 entity other than the Commonwealth, estate, trust, foundation or
- 9 individual.
- 10 SECTION 2. THE ADDITION OF SECTION 304.3 OF THE ACT SHALL <--
- 11 NOT BE CONSTRUED TO ALTER, REPEAL OR SUPERSEDE ANY PROVISION OF
- 12 THE ACT OF OCTOBER 13, 2010 (P.L.506, NO.72), KNOWN AS THE
- 13 CONSTRUCTION WORKPLACE MISCLASSIFICATION ACT.
- 14 Section $\frac{2}{3}$. This act shall take effect in $\frac{60}{180}$ 180 days. <--
